<p>ELD Instruction (What will EL teachers do?)</p>	<p>For K-8 Students:</p> <p>All EL students receive core instruction from their classroom teacher. EL teacher supports content area teachers with implementing sheltered instruction strategies and linguistic accommodations.</p> <p>EL teacher will host a weekly meeting through video call to support academic speaking. All EL students may join.</p> <p>Language Proficiency Level 1-3: EL services are carried out through lessons on Schoology or Study Island. The EL teacher will record lessons and assignments that students will complete and submit back to teacher.</p> <p>EL teacher may meet some students (level 1 or 2) in person or through video call to support oral language development as needed.</p> <p>The EL teacher may host group zoom calls as needed with student.</p> <p>Language Proficiency Level 3-4: EL teacher may assign lessons on Schoology and Study Island as needed to support language development. EL teacher collaborates with content area teachers to help the students access grade-level academic content and language.</p>	<p>EL Teacher EL Coordinator</p>
<p>Content Area EL Support (What will content teachers do to support English learners?)</p>	<p>The EL teacher and content area teachers will ensure consistent collaboration with classroom teachers through virtual meetings or email communications at least once a week.</p>	<p>EL Teacher EL Coordinator</p>
<p>Communicating with Multilingual/Multicultural Families</p>	<p>The EL teacher will communicate with families by phone, email, and video call. The EL teacher will be available for contact each day, including extra time on Fridays. EL teacher will contact families as needed using interpreters.</p>	<p>EL Teacher EL Coordinator Interpreters as needed</p>
